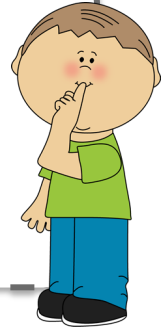


A pronoun takes the place of one or more nouns.

The pronouns **I, he, she, it,** and **you** are singular pronouns.

A pronoun must match the noun that it replaces.

Some pronouns refer to people or things that are not named.
